1. DELEGATION'S RETURN FROM MOSCOW

(FEB. 2, 1250, 1900 MRS) THE GOVERNMENT DELEGATION RETURNED FROM ITS MOSCOW VISIT ON SATURDAY. IT WAS GREETED AT THE STATION BY FIRST VICE-PREMIER DOLANSKY AND OTHER HIGH OFFICIALS. THOUSANDS OF PRAGUE CITIZENS ASSEMBLED IN FRONT OF THE MAIN STATION. - PRESIDENT ZAPOTOCKY, AFTER REVIEWING A GUARD OF HONOR, EXPRESSED DEEP SATISFACTION AT THE COMPLETE SUCCESS OF THE MOSCOW TALKS. INTERNATIONAL REACTION WORRIED GREATLY ABOUT WHICH PROBLEMS WE SHALL BE SOLVING. WE WENT TO MOSCOW, HOWEVER, WITH THE KNOWLEDGE OF COMPLETE UNITY BETWEEN OUR TWO COUNTRIES. THE RESULTS OF THE NEGOTIATIONS MEAN ABOVE ALL A STRENGTHENING OF OUR ALLIANCE AND FRIENDSHIP ON ALL FIELDS. HE SPOKE OF THE DANGER OF GERMAN REMILITARIZATION WHICH IS A THREAT TO WORLD PEACE. THE IMPORTANCE OF THE WARSAW AGREEMENT IS ALL THE MORE IMPORTANT FOR BOTH COUNTRIES, BECAUSE OF THAT DANGER. - AT THE END OF HIS SPEECH, ZAPOTOCKY ANNOUNCED THAT THE SOVIET LEADERS HAVE ACCEPTED AN INVITATION TO PAY AN OFFICIAL VISIT TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

(A REPORT ON THE DELEGATION'S RETURN AT 1900 HRS SAID THAT MEMBERS OF THE DELEGATION DID NOT USE CARS, BUT WALKED THROUGH THE CROWDS DOWN THE MAIN STREETS.)

(FEB 3, 0845 £4) THE SUNDAY PROGRAM "LIVE WORDS" BY WRITER KUPKA WAS ON SOVIET -CZSL. FRIENDSHIP.

(FEB 3, 1900 HRS PRAGUE AND BRATISLAVA) INTERNATIONAL COMMENTARIES BY SUBRT AND PORIEC WERE DEVOTED TO THE SUCCESSFUL MOSCOW TALKS.

FEB 2: (1900 HRS) AN EXHIBITION SHOWING HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS IN 20 EUROPEAN AND OVERSEAS COUNTRIES SINCE THE WAR WAS OPENED IN PRAGUE. (1900 HRS) THE FIRST DISTRICT CONFERENCE OF COLLECTIVE FARMS WAS HELD IN BLATNA, WHERE FARMERS HAVE AN AVERAGE YIELD OF 26 &. PER HECTAR, AND RECENTLY FOUNDED 24 NEW COLLECTIVES.

(1050 HRS BRATISLAVA) THE BRATISLAVA "LIVE WORDS", WRITTEN BY JEAN RUPPELT, AN ENGLISHWOMAN, DESCRIBED HER FIRST IMPRESSIONS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN 1951. AT THE TIME, SHE ATTENDED A PEACE MEETING AND SIGNED AN APPEAL WHICH SHE THOUGHT WAS A PEACE APPEAL. ACTUALLY, IT WAS AN APPLICATION TO BE VOLUNTEER FIRE -BRIGADER. AT THE TIME, ALSO, SHE HAD TO STAND QUEUES FOR EVERY ARTICLE. NOW, EVERYTHING HAS CHANGED AND SHE IS HAPPY TO LIVE IN HER SECOND, SOCIALIST COUNTRY.

(1900 HRS) A COMMENTARY ON CZSL-CHINESE TRADE SAID IT HAS GROWN FIVE TIMES SINCE 1950.

(1300 HRS BRATISLAVA) THE PROGRAM CRITICIZED THE VIENNA RADIO FOR INCORRECT INFORMATION ABOUT CZECHOSLOVAKIA. IT HAD BROADCAST A REPORT THAT THE GOVERNMENT HAS LOWERED THE PRICES IT PAYS FOR SOME AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS.

(Ø745 HRS) THE AUSTRIAN GOVERNMENT HAS BANNED THE ACTIVITIES OF THE WORLD COUNCIL OF PEACE IN AUSTRIA.

1. PRESS REVIEW FOR FEB 2

(1000 HRS) NEPSZABADSAG DISCUSSES THE PROBLEM OF TEACHERS, SOME OF WHOM SUPPORTED THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION. AS A RESULT, A MOOD HOSTILE TO THEM EXISTS THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY, AND THEY ARE BEING ATTACKED BY BOTH THE RIGHT AND THE LEFT. SOME MEMBERS OF THE CLERGY ARE OPENLY VOICING RIGHTIST DEMANDS SUCH AS CREATION OF CHAPELS IN SCHOOLS, WHILE CHURCH LEADERS IN GYOR-SOPRON COUNTY WANTED TEACHERS TO HOLD SEMINARS

ON THE LIFE STORY OF MINDSZENTY. THE NEWSPAPER SAYS THAT SUCH EXCESSES MUST BE FIRMLY COMBATTED. (AMONG THE EXCESSES WAS THE DISTRIBUTION OF LEAFLETS IN SOMOGY AND SZOLNIK COUNTIES WHICH INCLUDED SLOGANS DESIGNED TO TURN STUDENTS AGAINST TEACHERS.)

NEPAKARAT REPORTS THAT INVESTIGATION OF CASES OF ARBITRARY OCCUPATION OF APARTMENTS HAS STARTED. IN BUDAPEST ALONE, THERE ARE ESTIMATED TO BE 7,000 TO 8,000 SUCH CASES. THE INVESTIGATION IS BEING CARRIED OUT WITH DUE REGARD FOR SOCIAL CONSIDERATIONS AND NEEDS.

2 PRESS REVIEW FOR FEB 3

C1000 HRS) NEPSZABADSAG, REVIEWING THE SITUATION IN MINING,
SAID THE NUMBER OF MINES HAD INCREASED, AND THE GENERAL TREND IS
FAVORABLE. MINERS NOW WANT TO WORK AND PRODUCE. SUPPLIES OF MATERIAL
IS FAVORABLE. IN ANOTHER ARTICLE, THE PAPER SAYS THAT THE QUESTION
OF WHETHER THE EVENTS OF OCT 23 AND AFTER WERE COUNTER-REVOLUTION
STILL OCCUPIES THE MINDS OF MANY PEOPLE. THE GOVERNMENT HAS STATED ITS
POSITION UNEQUIVOCALLY. IT GOES ON TO EXPLAIN THAT THE OLD POLICIES
AND LEADERSHIP HAD BECOME UNTENABLE, AND UNFORTUNATELY THE INCREASE
OF BENEFICIAL CHANGES DID NOT KEEP PACE WITH THE GROWING WRATH OF THE
PEOPLE, WHO WERE ARTIFICIALLY INCITED. IN THE EVENTS WHICH SWEPT
AWAY THE CLIQUE OF DISCREDITED POLITICIANS ARMED COUNTERREVOLUTIONARY GANGS DID PLAY A PART, AND THEIR AIM WAS THE
RESTITUTION OF AN ANTI-POPULAR REGIME. THE REALIZATION OF THE JUST
DEMANDS OF THE PEOPLE WAS ACHIEVED BY THE NEW GOVERNMENT, WHICH NOW
ADVANCES TOGETHER WITH THE PEOPLE.

3. STATEMENT BY MEFESZ
(FEB 2, 2200 HRS) THE TEMPORARY EXECUTIVE OF THE NATIONAL UNION
OF UNIVERSITY STUDENTS HAS APPROVED A RESOLUTION ON THE RESUMPTION OF
TEACHING IN UNIVERSITIES. THE RESOLUTION APPEALS TO ALL STUDENTS
TO OPPOSE ALL PROVOCATION WHICH WOULD CREATE DISTURBANCES. THE RESOLUTIVE
STRESSES THAT THE STUDENTS' MAIN TAKS MUST BE TO LEARN. THE THREE
MONTHS WHICH WERE LOST MUST BE MADE GOOD.

4. STATE OF AGRICULTURE

(FEB 2, 1930 HRS) DEPUTY MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE ANDRAS MAGYARI SAID IN AN INTERVIEW THAT THE MAJORITY OF FARMERS DID NOT TAKE PART IN THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION, AND AUTUMN FIELD WORK WAS MOSTLY PERFORMED. A SUBSTANTIAL NUMBER OF COOPERATIVE FARMS WAS DISSOLVED, AND IN MANY CASES COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES SUCCEEDED IN INFLITRATING MACHINE TRACTOR STATIONS. HOWEVER, THE SITUATION HAS IMPROVED, AND THERE ARE SIGNS THAT THE GOVERNMENT PROGRAM HAS MET WITH FULL APPROVAL. THE MINISTRY IS WORKING OUT A DETAILED PROGRAM FOR AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT.

5. MAROSAN SPEECH

(FEB 3, 2000 HRS) MAROSAN ADDRESSED AN ACTIVISTS' MEETING IN BEKESCSABA.
